REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Contractors will need to obtain a building permit (when applicable) from the Planning and Development Department and business license from Commissioner of the Revenue's office prior to work being performed in the City of Lexington, VA.**

- 2. Contractors will need to provide a copy of their Virginia Contractor's License, Worker's Compensation Acknowledgement, location where the work is being performed and a list of subcontractors, contact information and their contract amounts.**

- 3. For payment of business license please make checks payable to the Treasurer, City of Lexington.

BUSINESS LICENSE INFORMATION

- All business license renewal applications, including payment of the tax are due by **MARCH 1**.
- If your business has paid the contract amount in full and will no longer be performing any work in the City of Lexington, please indicate "Do No Renew", sign and return the form to this office by **MARCH 1**.
- If Applicable, Contractors need to obtain Building Permits through the Planning & Development Department.
- Contractors must obtain a business license prior to performing any work in the City of Lexington.
- Contractors are assessed 16 cents per \$100 gross receipts. **All questions relating to calculating your business license tax should be directed to the Commissioner of the Revenue's office at (540) 462-3701.**
